## Something went "BANG"

#### in the Shed Last Week!!



Turns out our new SawStop Saw doesn't like wet wood. The "SawStop" mechanism (The Blue Bit ) is triggered by the completion of an electrical circuit.

This can be through a person touching the blade or very wet wood. Up to 15% moisture is fine – but the wood being cut was 34% moisture.

The blade was stopped last week, instantly, by the sacrificial "Dog" (The Silver bit) when a circuit was completed, by cutting wood with a high moisture content.

This required replacement of the blade and the trigger cartridge. (Expensive!)

## Sheddies must take care when cutting wet wood on the SawStop Saw.

A moisture meter has been place adjacent to the saw to facilitate moisture measurement and ensure this doesn't happen again.

If wet wood must be cut, then the safety mechanism can be switched off with a key,

But only by one of the two workshop supervisors, Bruce Hopwood or Douglas Ormrod.
