A Major Milestone for our 3rd Building Project

At the Orakei Local Board Business Meeting last week the agenda included the consideration of a lease extension for a 3rd building on the 400 sq m triangular piece of land immediately to the west of our barn.

Phil Oflaherty and Alan Minson did a brief presentation at the meeting, emphasizing the health and welfare purpose of the Shed.

The Board passed a resolution to prepare an "Agreement to Lease"!

Given it has been 3 years since our original proposal, achieving this milestone, is good news.

It is expected the 1st will be to obtain a Resource Consent. This will not be a simple matter because we are dealing with a building in a public park.
