**Perhaps Mal's biggest asset** is his ability to inspire and unify our many talented members


and leading them to achieve the many major milestones in our Shed's development.

Alan Minson, spoke on our behalf, acknowledging the huge contribution


Phil had made to the shed.



## Australia's Most Famous Poet, Banjo Paterson,

Presented lectures in the Auckland Opera House on the Boer War on 19-21 December 1900.

Paterson wrote many of his best known poems for the nationalist journal The Bulletin,

including "Clancy of the Overflow" (1889) and "The Man from Snowy River" (1890).

His 1895 ballad "Waltzing Matilda" is regarded widely as Australia's unofficial national anthem and

according to the National Film and Sound Archive, has been recorded more than any other Australian song.
