#### a HUGE SUCCESS !




Thanks to Chef's Bernie Ward and Graeme Collie who served a delicious roast, followed by Christmas pudding, custard and ice cream..

Other miscellaneous metals collected around the workshop added another \$330 to our cash recovery.


A double whammy, recycling junk and getting some cash to run the shed.




